



The Pernicious, Pervasive Role of George Soros

2011: Occupy Wall St. This group began under the leadership of Micah M. White, PhD, as a way of protesting the "corrosive power of banks". It spread to 82 countries and more than 1500 cities held protests. The whole idea was the brainchild of the *Adbuster* magazine group.

Adbuster received open payments from the Tides Centre (a donor clearing house), which received grants of \$3.5 million from Soros' Open Society organisation. An effective way of funneling cash without appearing to be the paymaster.

2012: Black Lives Matter. From what began as a reaction to police brutality soon became a war on the very notion of law enforcement...and this was the plan all along.

George Soros, in leaked memos, detailed how the group could be used to further certain agendas and be used as a catalyst. They received direct cash for "technological assistance" from Soros' organization. According to the *Washington Times*, #BLM received \$33 million from Soros.

2014: Euromaidan. This movement actually toppled the Ukrainian government, but received little press outside of Europe. The democratically elected leader of Ukraine was forced out of power for "not wanting to join the EU". The EU project is closely tied to George Soros and the idea that a sovereign nation state may not want to have itself subsumed by a Socialist propaganda machine was too much for the EU elites to cope with.

This was part of an ongoing campaign to destabilize the region and promote Soros' Globalist cause.

2016: Anti Trump. In the run up to the Presidential Election, and after the results were announced, many "spontaneous, grassroots movements" sprang up in protest against almost every statement made by Donald Trump. Supported and coddled by a compliant media, these groups were no more organic than plastic.

Soros' Open Society group has provided direct sponsorship, logistical support and "community organizers" to many of the supposedly organic protest movements.



More than 50 of the "Women's Marches" have direct ties to Soros. Be on the lookout for the next popular, well-funded organic movement. Do your own research and find out who is behind it. These organizations do not share your world view, they are merely stepping stones in an agenda that cares nothing for the causes it pays for.

Once each cause has served its purpose, the organizers and movement fall off the radar. Have you heard much from #BLM recently? What about Occupy? Have these causes been dealt with already? Or were they merely useful tools in pushing the pernicious and pervasive agenda of George Soros?
